

**Clark State Community College A.S. degree to
Central State University B.S. in Business Administration Degree,
Management Option**

Students who complete an A.S. degree at Clark State Community College may transfer into the B.S. in Business Administration Degree, Management Option program at Central State University. Students should verify their satisfactory academic progress (SAP) requirements with the financial aid office before pursuing classes outside of their A.A.B. degree requirements.

Admission Requirements to Degree Program at Central State University

1. 1. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Applicants who have attended any other college or university must have all official transcripts forwarded to the Central State University Admissions Office.
3. Courses accepted for transfer credit are subjected to meeting the requirements of the selected major.

Additional Information

Credits accepted from another institution are recorded on the student's permanent academic record, but grades are not transferred to the record. Only courses completed at Central State University are included in the cumulative grade point average.
