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## ***Join the Wright Path Program***

Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at [wright.edu/wrightpath/clark-state](http://wright.edu/wrightpath/clark-state).

High School students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Clark State College students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

## ***Transfer to Wright State University***

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Clark State College in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester:	<b>April 1</b>
Spring Semester:	<b>October 15</b>
Summer Semester:	<b>February 1</b>

Students must apply to the Undergraduate Admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Clark State College.

In order to be admitted fully as an integrated human services major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.35 with a minimum of C or higher in each professional integrated human services course requirement.

Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1111 at Clark State.
