Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester: **April 1**
Spring Semester: **October 15**
Summer Semester: **February 1**

Students must apply to the Undergraduate Admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Clark State College.

In order to be admitted fully as a bachelor of technical and applied studies major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0. In addition, students must earn a C or higher in ENG 1111 at Clark State and three Ohio Transfer 36 courses in Mathematics, Arts & Humanities, or Social & Behavioral Science.
